Why ezlase laser treatment?

Your dentist offers ezlase™ treatment to improve your comfort and provide better results from your dental procedures. ezlase™ laser treatment gives you important advantages over conventional treatment using scalpels and sutures.

What can the ezlase laser do?

Your dentist may use the ezlase™ laser to treat your gums or any other soft tissue in your mouth to:

Improve Your Smile

Your dentist may suggest contouring or shaping your gums using the ezlase[™] to improve the appearance of your smile – safely removing excess gum tissue that may give you a "gummy" smile, or make your front teeth appear irregular in size or shape.

Remove Oral Growths

Your dentist may use the ezlase[™] to remove growths or excess tissue in your mouth such as gum tissue over an unerupted tooth, small "tags" called papilla, growths called fibromas, and others.

Fix a "Tongue Tie" or Prevent Gum Recession

Connections that restrict the movement of your tongue or cause your gums to recede can be "released" with the ezlase $^{\text{TM}}$.

Treat or Prevent Periodontal Disease

Your dentist or dental hygienist* may recommend using the ezlase to remove debris and bacteria between your teeth and gums that can cause bleeding gums, gum recession and even loss of teeth. The laser is highly effective at killing bacteria and may even stimulate gum tissue growth.

Relieve the Pain of Cold Sores and Fever Blisters

The ezlase[™] often provides immediate relief from painful cold sores and fever blisters.

Your dentist may also use the ezlase[™] laser to perform other procedures not listed here.

How does the ezlase work – is it safe?

The ezlase™ is one of the most advanced dental instruments made today. It was developed by BIOLASE Technology, the number one company in dental lasers, with over 20 years of experience. BIOLASE dental lasers have been used to treat millions of patients.

The ezlase™ creates special, highly concentrated light energy, and sends it through an optical fiber to its handpiece. Your dentist uses the handpiece to aim the laser energy at precisely the areas to be treated.

The laser energy used by the ezlase was developed specifically to treat gum and other soft tissue in the mouth safely and comfortably. It can be harmful to eyes, however, so you, your dentist, and anyone else in the treatment room when the laser is being used must wear special protective glasses.
